
Sola's Hail payout turns weather data into speedy and transparent insurance for your home, avoiding the need for adjusters.

Sola guarantees payout when your house is damaged by 1.75 inches hail

When you notify us of hail damage to your home, our team will verify it using our system, which is **powered by data from the National**Weather Service. If we identify hailstones of 1.75 inches or larger, and you have sent us proof of damage*, you will qualify for a full payout (based on your policy limit).

If your home is damaged by hailstones smaller than 1.75 inches, that doesn't mean you don't get paid out. That's because we have a hail score calculation to determine the severity of a hail storm.

For a payout the hail storm needs to hit 65% hail score



What is the hail score?

Our Hail Score helps us identify damage based on the fact that each home has unique attributes that make its damage resistance different from that of another.

The Hail Score is calculated by analyzing National Weather Service Data to determine the size of hail and the duration of impact on a home, therefore indicating the cumulative impact of hail activity.

A 65% hail score indicates that the hailstorm has reached a significant level of hail size and duration, where we recommend you replace your roof. This information allows us to ensure fast, data-driven payouts.

*Damage: Sola requires proof of damage when filing a claim. This damage can be leaks, holes, or broken windows.
